Emotional/Behavioral Health/Substance Abuse

Wills Place- (417) 347-7700 – Complete Behavioral and Emotional Health Care. Children All ages. (Located in Joplin and Carl Junction) Offers licensed physicians specializing in mental health, therapy, play therapy, and case management. Accepts most insurance, MO Health, as well as sliding fee availability for the uninsured

Ozark Center- (417) 347-7630 Complete Behavioral and Emotional Health Care, including Substance Abuse Treatment. Adults. (Located in Carthage, Joplin, Neosho, and Lamar) Offers licensed physicians specializing in mental health, and substance abuse disorders. Medication Assisted therapy available, Therapy, and Case Management. Accepts most insurance, MO Health, as well as sliding fee availability for the uninsured.

Ozark Center Crisis Services- <u>(417) 347-7630</u> 24 hour line for urgent emotional/mental health needs. (ALL ages) Offers the ability to connect with a mental health professional for brief counseling and referral assistance. **Free of Charge**

Burrell Behavioral Health – <u>(417) 761–5000</u> – Comprehensive, quality care that includes therapy & counseling; psychiatric services; residential treatment; addiction recovery; crisis intervention; case management; developmental disability services; integrated services; evaluations; and autism services.

Tri-County Psychological Services Inc. – <u>417–859–7746</u> – A mental health clinic with multiple certifications and treatment programs. Services include: individuals; family and marriage; child and adolescent; aging; substance abuse; and drug court.

Suicide Hotline – 1–800–273–8255 – 24 Hour crisis hotline that offers support, counsel, and resources for those who are at risk of self-harm.

NAMI (Joplin) - (417) 781-6264 – National Alliance on Mental Illness. Provides Support Groups, and advocacy for those affected by mental health disorders. Free of Charge.

Alcoholics Anonymous- (417) 823-7125 12 step Recovery Programs and support for Alcoholism. Groups meet in many various locations throughout Southwest Missouri.

Al-Anon and Alateen- <u>1-888-425-2666</u> – free support for family members and loved ones living with those afflicted with substance abuse disorders.

Narcotics Anonymous- <u>1-800-561-2250</u> – 12 step groups, counsel and support for drug addictions.

SAMHSA's Hotline – 1-800-662-4357–24 hour, confidential hotline for drug and alcohol addiction. Assistance finding support, rehabilitation, Medication Assisted Therapy, and other resources.

Layfette House- 417-782-1772- In Patient Substance abuse treatment that allows children to stay with parents during treatment. Layafette House also focused on healing trauma related experiences.

Shelter, Food and Clothing

Carthage Crisis Center- (417) 358-3533 – Faith based shelter. Provides Emergency housing to both single adults, and families. Provides some assistance with food needs, and clothing for those in need, in the community.

Jasper County Division of Family Services- (417) 629–3065– Many essential need services to those individuals who fall below the income guidelines, and residing in Jasper County. Childcare for working parents, MO Health Net for the uninsured/underinsured, Home Energy Assistance, EBT Food Assistance, and Temporary Cash Assistance for children.

Jasper County Public Housing - (417) 781-0352 – Provides Low income Housing in Jasper County, Section 8 voucher program also available.

Domestic/ Family Abuse

Harmony House (Springfield) 417-864-7233 – Provides Emergency shelter, basic needs, transportation, advocacy, and counsel to persons and families wishing to flee domestic violence. Provides outreach counseling to those persons currently not in shelter wishing to receive confidential counsel on domestic violence.

Layafette House(Joplin) 417–782–1772 – Provides emergency shelter, resources, and treatment for comorbid substance abuse, and abuse issues, such as child abuse or domestic violence.

Freedom's Rest (Ozark) 417-299-2494 – Emergency Shelter and provision of basic needs for victims of domestic violence and their children.

Domestic Violence Hotline (National Hotline) 1-800-799-SAFE (7233 – Assists women who are currently in abusive homes by providing counsel, and locating immediate shelter, and other resources.

Domestic/ Family Abuse Cont.

Isabelle's House- (417) 865-2273 – Isabelle's House is a crisis Nursery for children up to the age of 12. All children are placed at Isabelle's house by their parent or guardians voluntarily on a temporary basis until some life situation can be resolved. This can be due to homelessness, domestic violence, lack of childcare, or other obstacles. Qualified and caring staff is available at Isabelle's to care for these children 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Child Abuse Hotline- 1-800-392-3738 – 24 hour hotline to call for suspected child abuse or neglect. Intake professionals will have appropriate staff in the County the child lives in investigate or assess the situation within 24 hours of your call.

Legal Aid of Western Mo- <u>417-782-1650</u> – Provides Free Legal assistance in cases of domestic abuse, child abuse, or other family law issues where a physical safety concern exists.

Crisis Pregnancy/ Newborns

Choices Medical Services (Joplin, and Carthage)- <u>417-388-3434</u> Free Pregnancy and STD testing. Counsel and referrals.

The Light House- <u>816-916-4434</u> or email <u>lighthouse@mbch.org.</u> Maternity Home for Pregnant mom's age 12-21 who are choosing to give birth. Offers shelter, meals, clothing, transportation, medical care, Counseling, schooling, resources including parenting classes and after planning for those wishing to raise their infants, or adoption services.

WIC(Women, Infants, and Children) – 417–623–1928– Assists pregnant, and nursing women, as well as formula fed babies, and children up to the age of 5 with nutritional needs.

Health/Dental

Community Clinic (Joplin)- (417) 624-5500 Charges 18% of any medical fees to those patients who are not covered by insurance. Prescription services are also available.

Jordan Valley (Springfield)-. (417) 851-1566 Charges a sliding fee for medical, behavioral, and dental services to the uninsured. Must bring proof of income

Access Family Health Care (Joplin) – (417) 782–6200 Charges a sliding fee for medical, behavioral, and dental services to the uninsured. Must bring proof of income

Jasper Medical Clinic (Carthage) – (417)358–3111 Charges a sliding fee for medical, behavioral, and dental services to the uninsured. Must bring proof of income.

Partnership for Prescription Assistance- 1-888-477-2669 free and confidential service that helps connect uninsured and underinsured patients who struggle with affordable access to medicines to prescription assistance programs that offer medicines for free or nearly free.

Joplin Public Health Department- (417)-623-6122 Pregnancy testing, Tuberculosis (TB) testing, HIV testing, Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STD) testing, Childhood immunization, Adult immunization, Flu vaccination, Enrollment in temporary Medicaid card and MO HealthNet, Low income pharmacy support
