

Sarcoxie R-II Summer School Handbook

8am-4:30pm Every Day!

Session 1: May 21-June 28 (M-Th Week 1; Tues-Fri Week 2; M-Th Weeks 3-6)

Session 2: July 9-August 9 (M-Th all 5 weeks)

Prizes will be given out by grade span every day: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12! Students will be eligible for prizes if they do not miss any time or get sent to the office for that day. Students may win more than once during summer school!

Attendance Incentives for full time enrollment for EACH Session of Summer School!:

Summer School Incentives will be paid in CASH!!!!!!

\$100 Dollar Bill--Less than 1 hour absent during summer school.

\$75—More than 1 hour, but less than 7 hours absent.

\$50—More than 7 hours, but less than 14 hours absent.

Please note: Absences are not excused for any reason since the state only pays for actual seat time.

Field Trips:

There will be 4 field trips in Session 1 and 3 field trips in Session 2.

City Pool:

Grades 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12 will get one afternoon each week to visit the city pool for free between 1pm and 3pm. The snack bar will be open if your child wants to bring money.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner: Free for Everyone! Breakfast and Lunch served at Wildwood Elementary.

Dinner served at Sarcoxie High School. Breakfast will be available from 7:30 to 8:30. Lunch will be available from 10:45 to 12:15. Dinner will be available from 3:50 to 4:30.

Behavior Code:

Summer school is a privilege. On strike 2, the child will be sent home for a day and lose time toward their attendance incentive.

3 strikes and you're out! Three trips to the office will result in immediate dismissal from summer school.
